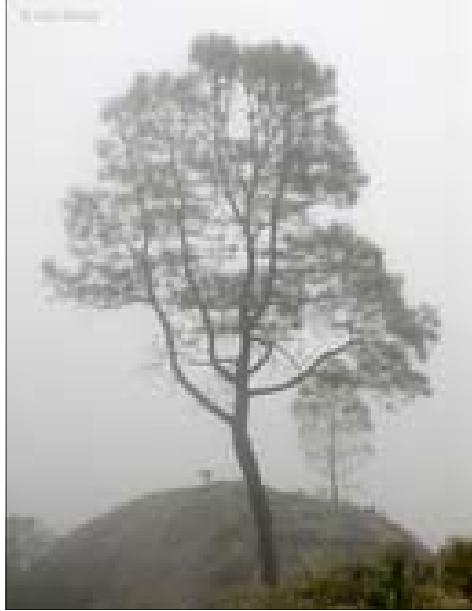
Pinus Ponderosa Laws

Pinus Sabiniana Douglas

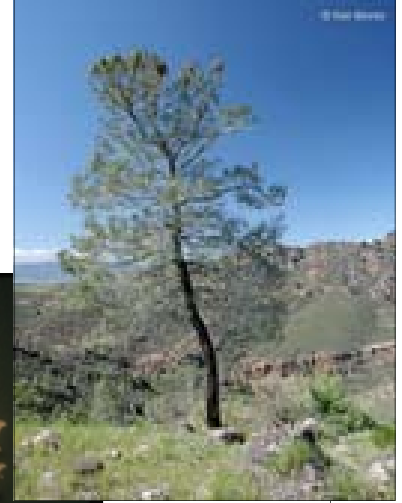
Pinus Sabiniana a gymnosperm, is a tree that is native to California and is endemic (limited) to California alone.

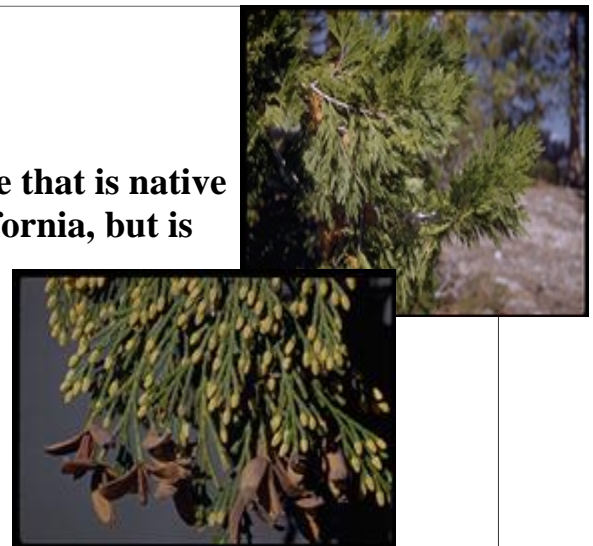
Incense Cedar

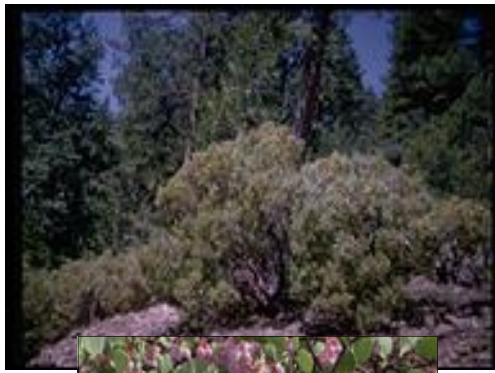
Cercocarpus Betuloides, a dicot, is a tree or shrub that is native to California and is also found outside of the California, but is confined to Western North America.

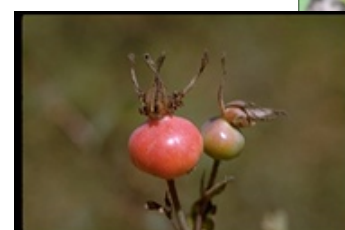
Rosa Californica, a dicot, is a shrub that is native to California and is also found outside of California, but is confined to Western North America.

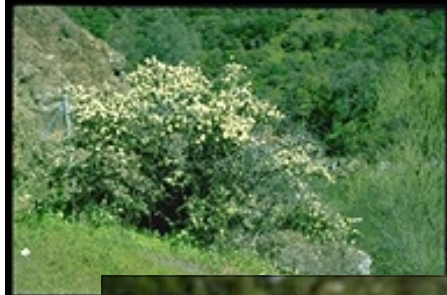
