Cases For discussion:

After nearly a week long investigation, Sonora Police officers arrested Kaliem Sage Campau, 18 of Sonora for assault with a deadly weapon and battery causing serious bodily injury. On 02-12-2018, Sonora Police officers learned of an assault that had occurred on or about 02-10-2018, at the abandoned saw mill located at 355 Hospital Road, Sonora. It was reported to officers that Campau had physically assaulted a fourteen year old victim during a party in the abandoned saw mill. Campau allegedly pulled the victim off of an elevated area, causing the victim to fall several feet. Campau then punched the victim several times in the face and then kicked the victim in the head, causing the victim to lose consciousness. The victim sustained serious injuries as a result of the assault. Since the initial report, officers have been investigating the allegations and finally caught up with Campau on 02-18-2018. Campau was arrested for felony assault charges and booked at the Tuolumne County Jail.

On 02-18-2018, at 10:15 AM, Sonora Police Officers were called to a report of a domestic disturbance in the area of Forest Road near Stockton Rd. Officers arrived in the area and located a female subject who had been involved in the disturbance. Officers determined the female had been in a physical fight with her boyfriend, identified as Joshua Howard Williamson, 37 of Sonora. The female alleged that Williamson struck her several times, causing visible injuries. Williamson also held the female down to prevent her from leaving the area. Williamson had left the area and officers were unable to locate him at that time. Officers also learned that Williamson was the restrained party in a valid criminal protective order where the female in this case was the protected person.

On 02-19-2018, Sonora Police Officers located Williamson walking along Stockton Road. Officers arrested Williamson for felony domestic battery and violation of a criminal protective order. Williamson was booked into the Tuolumne County Jail.

- Our entry level officer applicant has completed his background investigation and is continuing to move forward in the process.

Field Training Program:

- Officer Ashley Brandow has completed her field Training Program and has now working as a solo-officer.

Special/Community Events:

- On 02-21-2018, Coffee with a Cop was held at Eighty One, located at 81 S. Washington Street. Several members of the community showed up and participated in this event.
- Initial planning has begun for the 2018 Mother Lode Round-up Parade, which will take place on May 12th. Participating agencies have been contacted and planning meetings have tentatively been scheduled for mid to late April.

CASE(S) FOR DISCUSSION:

On 2-21-18, at about 11:30 p.m., a potential threat of violence at “SHS” began circulating on social media. As a result, our dispatch center was inundated throughout the night with calls from concerned students, parents and school staff. After many hours of investigative work and extensive collaboration with other law enforcement agencies and school officials, it was determined that this threat was likely a hoax and not related to either Sonora High School or Summerville High School. This same post was viral across the United States affecting multiple high schools and law enforcement agencies across the nation. The quick information sharing and cooperative efforts among local partners ensured that the spread of panic was minimized. As a matter of assurance, the Sonora Police Department increased staffing the following day to be present at all schools within the city.

On 02-07-18 at about 11:35 p.m., Sgt Rogers, our Fire Investigator, was called to 764 Mono Way (Be Wok Sushi) for a report of a structure fire. Upon arrival, the kitchen of the restaurant had been burned and the fire was contained to the kitchen area of the building. The cause of the fire was determined to be a result of spontaneous combustion due to the mis-storage of cooking oils and grease. The kitchen of the restaurant was completely damaged, and the restaurant remains closed until repairs can be made.

Range:

Training:

The Sonora Police Department hosted an ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate) instructor course at Columbia College on February 7 and February 8, 2018. There was approximately 50 students in the class from other areas throughout California in the class. With us sponsoring the class we had two additional officers, Sgt Wertz and Officer Hankins trained in ALICE and are now available to assist with teaching the program to our local schools and such.

Officer Mallon attended advanced officer, perishable skills training training in Modesto at the Stanislaus Peace officer academy.

Explorers/community Service Volunteers (CSV):

The Explorer Post is preparing for the possibility of attending an explorer competition in July. Until that time we will have training every Sunday evening at Sonora Fire Department.

The CSV group is continuously putting in hundreds of hours helping out our patrol. The jobs the CSV group does ranges from patrol, clerical and building maintenance (Janitorial)

Contract/Reserve Officers:

We have one officer is backgrounds for a Reserve Police Officer position.
