Case(s) for Discussion

On June 13, 2018 at about 2357 hrs, our officers were dispatched to Lowes for a verbal argument. Upon arrival Officer Durham spoke with two local transients, Josh Murray and Kendra Sanguinetti. Sanguinetti advised Officer Durham that she was trying to break up with Murray and wanted to stay away from him. She had received a protection order against him. While at a transient camp on Old Wards Ferry Road Murray and her were together in the camp in violation of the restraining order. She was attempting to locate her property which had been left in the camp.

While walking away from the camp Sanguinetti was texting a friend for a ride. Murray got upset and accused her of cheating on him. He pushed her and took her phone from her and would not give it back. Murray was later arrested for robbery, domestic battery and violation of restraining order and was booked into the county jail.

On June 7, 2018, at about 1423 hrs, Chief Vanderweil was working patrol when he was dispatched to Walmart for a shop lifter in custody. When he arrived he spoke with Loss Prevention, Kevin Kolenborn about what occurred. Kolenborn directed Chief's attention to a subject he had detained. Kolenborn explained the subject had stolen about \$1,300 worth of camping equipment from the store. Kolenborn explained the shopping cart the subject tried leaving the store with was completely full when he was stopped from leaving the store. When Chief Vanderweil asked for the subjects name the subject gave a false name. The subject was taken to the Tuolumne County Sheriff's Office Jail for booking. The subject continued to give a false name. Eventually his name was found to be Noel Figueroa, A 20 year old transient from Sonora.

Figueroa had three warrants for his arrest for theft related charges. Figueroa was booked into the jail for grand theft, delaying or resisting a public officer and the three local warrants. He was booked into the jail without further incident.

Training:

- Sergeant Hankins attended a one day Glock Armorer course in Modesto. He is now able to perform required maintenance and repairs on our duty pistols.

Explorers and Community Service Volunteers:

- Both the Explorers and Community Service Volunteers provide great service to our agency and the community. They have put in hundreds of hours of volunteer time for the Police Department.
- We have had one new Explorer join our Explorer Program.
- We had four Explorers attend the Explorer Academy at the Stanislaus Regional Training Center. They all performed very well and returned with valuable lessons learned during the academy.

Contract/Reserve Officers:

- We have one Reserve Officer in the final stages of the hiring process.
- Officer Townsend continues to work numerous patrol shifts each week to supplement vacant positions.

Dispatch:

- We have one part-time dispatcher on the CTO Training Program.

Defensive Tactics Program:

- Officer Brandow has submitted for and has been accepted to be our department defensive tactics instructor. She will be attending training in the near future.

Cases For discussion:

18-713. On June 11th, 2018, just after midnight the Sonora Police Department responded to the area of South Washington Street and Linoberg Street for a fight involving multiple people. The parties had separated prior to the officer's arrival but officers discovered that a 57-year-old Sonora man was badly injured during the altercation. During the investigation, it was determined that 26-year-old Ariz Jacques of Sonora, 44-year-old Joseph Garcia of Sonora, and 26-year-old Avery Smith of Sonora were responsible for the injuries to the victim. Garcia and Smith were arrested at the scene, and Jacques was located and arrested a short distance from the scene. It is alleged that the fight, originating at a downtown bar, started because the victim had been disrespectful in the bar and was chased outside by Garcia and Smith where it became physical. At that point, it was reported that Jacques emerged and began beating and kicking the victim while he was on the ground. The victim sustained injuries to his head and was evacuated to a valley hospital for treatment. All three suspects were arrested for contributing to the felony battery and booked into the county jail with a bail set at \$50,000 each.

On June 4, 2018, at about 6:40pm, Sonora Police received a 911 call reference a fight in the 200 block of Mono Way. Officers' arrived on scene and determined Daenon Brewer, 27, of Sonora tried to take cigarettes from a business. The victim took the cigarettes back and Brewer hit the victim several times while stating he was going to get a cigarette. Officers' attempted to contact Brewer who was walking nearby. Brewer took off running and was caught after about a 300 yard foot pursuit up Trunkenmiller Rd. Brewer was arrested for attempted robbery and delaying/obstructing a peace officer. Brewer is on active parole, and a hold was placed on him. Brewer was booked at the Tuolumne County Jail with no bail due to the violation of parole.

Recruitments:

- Our entry level officer applicant has completed his background investigation. He is slated to start the Police Academy in August. Our

Vets to Cop candidate has completed his background investigation. He is slated to start the Police Academy on Monday, July 2nd. We had oral interviews on June 21, 2018. Five out of the six candidates passed the written and oral portion of the testing. The top three will move onto a Chief's interview where two will be put into the background process.

Field Training Program:

- There are no trainees currently assigned to the Field Training Program.

Community/Special Events:

- Several members of Sonora PD participated in the Special Olympic Torch Run in Sonora. This is the largest fundraising event for Special Olympic Athletes in Tuolumne County.
- Plans are in place for crosswalk and parking details for the Mother Lode Fair July 5-8. A DUI patrol vehicle will be on-duty for July 6th and 7th.
- Coffee with a Cop will take place the last week in July.

Range:

- Sergeant Hankins attended a Glock Armorer's course at Modesto PD. All issued weapons will be taken apart and inspected on an annual basis.
- The next range date will be Wednesday, July 25, 2018.
