### **Case(s) for Discussion**

On 4-23-18, at approximately 0904 hours, the Police Department received a 911 call regarding a suspicious circumstance at 304 Stockton Road. The caller who was walking by heard a female asking for help. When officers arrived they found a female on the floor of the apartment in partial fetal position. It was found Michael Shaun Fuller had battered his live in girlfriend. When she tried to leave the apartment she was stopped by Fuller at the middle of the stairs. The Victim was pulled back of up the stairs and back into the apartment where she was held against her will.

She attempted to make phone calls for help in which time Fuller refused her the use of the phone. Fuller would not allow her leave the apartment until we arrived. At one point Fuller threw a bag of children's toys at the victim which hit her and broke open. The victim had minor injuries.

Fuller was arrested for domestic battery, Kidnapping, and false imprisonment. Additional charges were asked for regarding vandalism and interfering with wireless communications. Fuller was booked with a bail of \$100,000.00.

### **Field Training Program:**

- There are currently no Officers in the Field Training Program.

## **Area 2 Monthly Report April 2018**

### **NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH:**

### **Special Events:**

- Sergeant Wertz attended the a fundraiser dinner at Black Oak Casino. This was a fund raiser event for construction of parks for disabled children.
- We had an inventory check of our patrol rifles which were loaned to us through the LESO program. We passed this audit of Government issued rifles.

### **CASE(s) FOR DISCUSSION:**

On April 7, 2018, Officers were dispatched to the 250 Greenly Road apartments for a report of a domestic violence call. Upon arrival, they spoke with the victim who stated she had been assaulted by her husband. The victim stated her husband, Dena Borrelli had grabbed her by the hair during an argument and forced her to the ground.

A short time later Borelli put his finger in the victims right eye socket and activated a stun gun numerous times in her direction which caused her to feel threatened. The victim stated the domestic violence "Happens all the time." The sustained minor injuries. There was also a small abrasion on her shoulder from the altercation.

Borelli was arrested for felony domestic battery causing injury and booked into the Tuolumne County Jail. His bail was set at \$35,000.00.

### **Range:**

- Range qualifications were held this month for our full time Officers and retired Officers. There were also City Council members on site to participate in weapons training.

### **Training:**

- The Sonora Police Department and Tuolumne County Sheriff's Office conducted numerous school ALICE (Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter, Evacuate) presentations in numerous County and City Schools.
- The Sonora Police Department hosted an Outlaw Motorcycle gang class at the Tuolumne County EOC (Emergency Operations Center.) Numerous county agencies and out of county agencies attended.
- Officer Weber attended Range Master School for two weeks in Sacramento. Officer Weber will now be assisting with the Range qualifications and range duties.
- Part time Dispatcher Cyndi Nordvik attended 24 hours of Advanced Dispatcher training in Merced.
- Officer Brandow attended Drager class with the Department of Justice on April 11, 2018.
- Officer's Durham and Brandow attended a twenty four hour course in Patrol Rifle operations and handling at our range. They are now qualified to carry the patrol rifle during their patrol shifts.
- Sergeant Wertz Attended a Community Crisis Response Team Training. This training was put on by the Tuolumne County Health Department for forming of a county wide crisis response team.
- Sergeant Wertz attended a one day POST manager course in Calaveras County on May 10, 2018.

### Explorers/community Service Volunteers (CSV):

- The Explorer program is preparing to attend an Explorer Academy this summer. Until that time we will have training every other Sunday evening at the Sonora Fire Department when available.
- The Explorers and CSV groups were used for many events this month. The Home and Garden show was at the fairgrounds where they performed parking detail for the event.
- Two CSV personnel were foot patrol during the Spring Festival in Downtown Sonora.
- We had numerous Explorer presentations this month. Our goal is to attract other Explorer, age 14 to 20 year olds to join the Explorer program
- The CSV group is continuously putting in hundreds of hours helping out our patrol officers. The jobs the CSV group does range from patrol, clerical and building maintenance (Janitorial)

### Contract/Reserve Officers:

- We have one officer in backgrounds for a reserve position. Vicky Chew is conducting the background.
