Case(s) for Discussion:

On September 19, 2018, at about 8 pm, Officers responded to 578 West Stockton Street for a report of a subject wanted for charges of felony domestic violence. We were given information the suspect was inside the business of Throttle Jockeys. It had been reported to the police department the subject, Adric Robert White had choked his girlfriend to the point the lack of oxygen popped blood vessels in her eye and left bruises on her neck.

When the units arrived at the business, the lights inside the business shut off, a motorcycle shut off, and a subject was seen running to hide inside the business. Officers knocked on the doors and eventually got a response from White inside who came outside and met with the Officers. White exited the store and then became argumentative and aggressive with officers. He was taken into custody and booked into the Tuolumne County Jail for, Corporal Injury on spouse or Cohabitant and, resisting or obstructing a peace officer in the performance of his/her duties. White was booked into the Tuolumne County Jail, with bail set at \$35,000.

Training:

- We passed our annual POST Audit this month.
- In September Sgt Wertz and Officer Mallon attended Field Training Officer Update course in Napa. This course is required by POST for our field training personnel training our new hire employees.
- Thomas Brickley is currently in the Basic Post Academy being sponsored by our agency at the San Joaquin Delta College.

Explorers and Community Service Volunteers:

- Both the Explorers and Community Service Volunteers provide great service to our agency and the community. They have put in hundreds of hours of volunteer time for the Police Department.
- The Explorers and CSV units are now providing parking assistance at the PG&E lot for Sonora High School Football games.

Contract/Reserve Officers:

- We have one Reserve Officer who has been given a start in October and will be entering the Field Training Program.
- I have received interest from two other subjects who are interested in the Reserve Program.
- Officer Townsend continues to work numerous patrol shifts each week to supplement vacant positions.

Dispatch:

- We have one part-time Dispatch position open. No one is in the CTO Training Program at this time.

Defensive Tactics Program:

- We are in the process of obtaining information on a new Defensive Tactics Program and will be evaluating the program shortly for possible implementation.

Cases For discussion:

18-1138. On Saturday, September 1, 2018, just after midnight, Officers were advised via radio by one of the departments volunteer units that there was a physical fight in front of the Office Bar. Upon arrival an Officer ordered both of the involved males to sit on the curb, neither of them listened. The Officer immediately detained Nokes but the second subject Banks was cursing and continued to be uncooperative. He was attempting to pull away to go after Nokes. TCSO deputies arrived and were able to assist in detaining Banks. 55-year-old Randal Banks of Sonora and 43-year-old Lance Nokes of Jamestown were arrested for Battery with Serious injury and Fighting in Public. An additional charge of Obstructing or Delaying a Peace Officer was sought against Banks.

18-1159. On Thursday, September 6, 2018, at around 11:40 a.m., the Sonora Police Department received a call regarding smoke coming from underneath the Intake Bar and Grill on S. Washington Street. Fire personnel were dispatched and Police Officers responded to the scene and accessed the source of the smoke from the underneath the Sonora Creek bridge. A wooden support beam was actively burning along with some articles of trash. Within minutes the Officers were able to extinguish the flames using a bucket and water from the creek. On September 10, 2018 at about 7:59pm, Stanley Jesse Wooden, of Sonora, was arrested for arson. During an interview, Wooden admitted to starting the fire. The investigation is still active. Wooden was booked at the Tuolumne County Jail for arson of an inhabited building with a bail of \$75,000.00.

- Our Recruit level Officer started the Police Academy August 4th, and is doing well. Our Vets to Cop Officer is currently in the final phases of the hiring process. An Entry level Officer has just started the hiring process. Another Entry level Officer is scheduled to start Field Training on October 7th.

- On September 11th, our Police Explorers placed American flags downtown in observance of Patriot Day.
