Case(s) for Discussion:

On 12/13/18, Wal-Mart discovered almost \$4000.00 worth of jewelry was stolen from a display case. The theft was caught on surveillance cameras. While conducting follow-up on 12/14/18, SPD Officers' learned the suspect was just seen in the store and left running out of the automotive department exit. The Officers' did an extensive area check and found the suspect, Steven Michaels Hoch (24, Sonora) hiding in some bushes behind Lowe's. Hoch was booked into county jail for felony theft (Jewelry) and felony vandalism (Display case).

On 12/20/18, the Sonora Police Department arrested 28-year-old Amanda Burback of Murphy's for attempted homicide following an altercation that resulted in a stabbing.

At approximately 10:08 a.m., the Police Department received a 9-1-1 call concerning a physical fight in progress between two females at the business parking lot of 130 Stockton Road. When officers arrived on scene, they identified Burback as one of the involved parties but were unable to identify who the other party was. A short time later, the other involved female arrived at the Adventist Health Emergency Room reporting to have been stabbed.

Our investigation revealed that Burback and another adult female began fighting over a prior boyfriend. During the physical altercation, Burback produced a pocket knife and stabbed the victim two times in the abdomen while threatening to kill her. The assault ended, and the parties dispersed as the sound of police sirens approached.

Ultimately, Burback was arrested for attempted homicide and booked at the Tuolumne County Jail. The stab victim's injuries do not appear to be life-threatening.

- Thomas Brickley is currently in the Basic Post Academy being sponsored by our agency at the San Joaquin Delta College. He is due to graduate mid February.
- Krishna Livingston attended a 24 hour update course for dispatch in Pleasanton
- Chief VanderWiel attended a 24 hour police executive course in Sacramento

Explorers and Community Service Volunteers:

- Both the Explorers and Community Service Volunteers provide great service to our agency and the community. They have put in hundreds of hours of volunteer time for the Police Department.
- The Explorers and CSV units assisted with many events this month including the Shop with a Cop program at Wal-Mart.
- The Explorers had two meetings this month.

Contract/Reserve Officers:

- Reserve Officer Danny Duffy has started with our agency and is now in the Field Training Program.
- We have one in background for a Reserve Officer position.
- Officer Townsend continues to work numerous patrol shifts each week to supplement vacant positions and open shifts.

Dispatch:

- We have one part-time Dispatch position open. No one is in the CTO Training Program at this time.

Defensive Tactics Program:

- We are in the process of obtaining information on a new Defensive Tactics Program and will be evaluating the program shortly for possible implementation.

18-1531. On December 7, 2018 at 1:59 am, Aaron Hagerman, age 35 of Sonora, came into the Sonora Police Department where he was arrested for failing to register as a sex offender. Hagerman was found to be in possession of a counterfeit \$100 bill, and methamphetamine. He was booked at the county jail for his charges.

18-1601. On December 21, 2018, at 9:46 am, SPD dispatch was advised of a disturbance at 428 S. Barretta St. The downstairs neighbor went upstairs to ask Laura Fowler, age 40 of Sonora, to turn her music down. Fowler responded by punching a window out and yelling at the neighbor to leave. Fowler then picked up some of the broken glass and threw it at the neighbor. The neighbor blocked the glass from hitting her face with her hand. The glass cut her hand. Fowler was arrested for Assault with a Deadly Weapon, and booked at the Tuolumne County Jail.
