**RE: 2019 MOTHER LODGE ROUND-UP PARADE/RODEO**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended the City Council adopt Resolution Number 04-01-2019-A, authorizing the closure of State Route 49 (Washington Street & Stockton Road), along with certain other City Streets for the 2019 Mother Lode Round-Up Parade and Rodeo.

**BACKGROUND:**

Each year the Tuolumne County Sheriff's Posse sponsors the Mother Lode Round-Up Parade on the Saturday proceeding Mother's Day. This year the Parade will be held on Saturday 11 May 2019. It is scheduled to begin at 10:00 A.M. and will conclude at approximately 1:00 P.M. The Rodeo will be held Saturday 12, and Sunday 12 May 2019.

**DISCUSSION:**

This year's Mother Lode Round-Up Parade will be held on Saturday, 11 May 2019. Once again, "NO PARKING" will be allowed on the side streets between Washington and Green Street, and Washington and Stewart Street. This gives participants a secure area to view the parade; plus allows a safer, as well as a more controlled area for pedestrians to travel in following the conclusion of the parade. In addition, traffic will be held for approx. 15 minutes following the parade, allowing spectators sufficient time to clear the streets.

Due to the size and duration of the parade, a resolution is required from the City Council authorizing the temporary closure of State Route 49 (Washington Street), specific City streets, as well as the temporary elimination of parking on State Route 49 (Washington Street and Stockton Road), along with specified City streets for the event.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SONORA, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE TEMPORARY PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON, AND THE CLOSURE OF, STATE ROUTE 49 (WASHINGTON STREET & STOCKTON ROAD) IN CONJUNCTION WITH CERTAIN CITY STREETS TO ACCOMMODATE THE MOTHER LODE ROUND-UP PARADE, SATURDAY, 11 MAY 2019, AND OTHER PARKING RESTRICTIONS TO ACCOMMODATE THE RODEO TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY 12 MAY, AND SUNDAY 12 MAY 2019.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SONORA THAT THE FOLLOWING STREETS BE CLOSED ON SATURDAY 11 MAY 2019, COMMENCING AT 9:30 AM AND SHALL REMAIN CLOSED UNTIL 1:00 PM, UNLESS OPENED EARLIER UPON THE AUTHORITY OF THE SONORA POLICE DEPARTMENT.**

1. State Route 49 (Washington Street) from Snell and Elkin Streets to State Route 49 (Stockton Road).
2. South Washington Street from State Route 49 (Stockton Road) to State Route 108.
3. State Route 49 (Stockton Road) from S. Green Street to S. Washington Street.

5. School Street from State Route 49 (Washington Street) to Snell Street.

1. South Washington Street at SR 108 (7:30 A.M.).
2. Restano Way, eastbound right turn lane onto Mono Way (8:00 A.M.), with the remainder of Restano Way closing at 9:30 A.M.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT “NO PARKING” WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE FOLLOWING STREETS ON SATURDAY 11 MAY 2019, COMMENCING AT 5:00 AM AND SHALL REMAIN “NO PARKING” ZONES UNTIL 1:00 PM, UNLESS OPENED EARLIER UPON THE AUTHORITY OF THE SONORA POLICE DEPARTMENT:**

1. East and West sides of State Route 49 (Washington Street) from Elkin Street to Toby Street.
2. North and South sides of State Route 49 (Stockton Road), between S. Washington Street and 70 Stockton Road.
3. Stewart Street between Elkin Street and East Dodge Street.
4. North side of Lyons Street between Stewart Street and Shepherd Street.
5. South side of Lyons Street between Shepherd Street and Barretta Street.
6. Snell Street from State Route 49 (Washington Street) to Bonanza Road.
7. School Street from State Route 49 (Washington Street) to Snell Street.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT “NO PARKING” WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE FOLLOWING STREETS COMMENCING ON SATURDAY 11 MAY 2019, AT 5:00 AM UNTIL SUNDAY 12 MAY 2019 AT 5:00 PM:**

1. There will be no parking at the south/east corner of the intersection of State Route 49 (Stockton Road) and Southgate Drive, in the area of the locomotive.
2. There will be no parking on the east side of Solinsky Street between State Route 49 (Stockton Road) and West Jackson Street.
3. There will be no parking on Fairview Lane between State Route 49 (Stockton Road) and the driveway into the Tuolumne County Superintendent of Schools Office.
4. There will be no parking on Forest Road between State Route 49 (Stockton Road) and the driveway into Sonora Regional Prompt Care.
5. There will be no parking at the south/east corner of the intersection of State Route 49 (Stockton Road) and Southgate Drive, in the area of the locomotive.
6. There will be no parking on the east side of Solinsky Street between State Route 49 (Stockton Road) and West Jackson Street.
7. There will be no parking on Fairview Lane between State Route 49 (Stockton Road) and the driveway into the Tuolumne County Superintendent of Schools Office.

1. The Terzich parking structure located on State Route 49 (Washington Street), second level, front row, accessed of S. Green Street.
2. The Fountain parking lot located at the south/east corner of the intersection of S. Washington Street and East Church Street.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT ALL VENDORS DURING THE PARADE MUST POSSESS A VALID CITY BUSINESS LICNESE.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the City Council of the City of Sonora that all of the above is hereby approved, subject to the Tuolumne County Sheriff’s Posse meeting all liability insurance requirements as specified by the City of Sonora, and having met all conditions as required by the California Department of Transportation.
