SUBJECT: SB 1 FY 2019 Funding

Attached is Resolution No. 4-16-2018-A that the City is required to adopt to receive the City's FY 2019 SB 1 funding allocation. This is a new process and the City's request will be submitted through an on-line portal. The City will be receiving \$33,537 in the current fiscal year. For FY 2019, this amount will be \$86,993, an increase of \$53,456.

As funds become available, the City staff would propose that they be used for street overlay projects. Given the amounts available and the anticipated costs of the overlay projects, allocations may need to be carried over from year to year to have sufficient funds.

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-19 FUNDED BY
SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017**

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City must adopt a list of all projects proposed to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1 by resolution, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City, will receive and estimated \$86,993 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2018-19 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the second year in which the City is receiving SB 1 funding and will enable the City to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repairing and replacing aging bridges, and increasing access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the City has provided for public comment at a public meeting to ensure public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the City used a Pavement Management System that maintains an inventory of the City's streets and their classification, characteristics and most recent maintenance to develop the SB 1 project list to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the City maintain and rehabilitate approximately one-half mile or more of streets/roads throughout the City this year and dozens of similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2016 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the City streets and roads are in a poor condition and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into a good condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 funded projects for our local streets and roads infrastructure will focus on basic maintenance and safety, investing in complete streets infrastructure where possible, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, to leverage the most positive benefits locally and by extension statewide.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the City Council of the City of Sonora, California, as follows:

1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
2. The fiscal year 2018-19 list of projects planned to be funded with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues include:

Street overlay project(s) as the amount of funding allows, in various locations throughout the City beginning in the Spring of 2019 with a useful life of at least fifteen years.
