RE: Tap Room "Summer Kick-Off" – June 23

A request has been received from Nayland Chappell, owner and manager of the Sonora Tap Room to host their second 2018 event utilizing Linoberg Street on Saturday, June 23rd (see attached letter). Linoberg Street would be closed between Stewart and Washington Streets. Activities would include music and feature Dust Bowl Brewing from Turlock. Attendance is estimated at approximately fifty people. The possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages (beer and wine) would be limited to the business and the confines of the secured area. Entrance would be controlled and security would be provided. The street closure would extend from 5 PM until 11 PM with the event occurring between 7 PM and 10 PM (see attached street exhibit).

The Sonora Municipal Code, as amended by Ordinance No. 827, provides authority for the Council to grant approval to possess and consume alcohol at public parks, streets, sidewalks, and etc. It is recommended that the City Council authorize the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages, between the hours of 7:00 PM to 10:00 PM, subject to the following:

- Obtain Special Event Permit for the street closure
- Obtain the required ABC license
- Provide the required liability insurance
- Provide exit and no smoking signs, fire extinguishers and occupancy limits as required by the Fire Department
- Provide security staffing at all entrance/exit location(s) as required by the Police Department and limit entrance location(s) as required by ABC
- Place "no alcohol beyond this point" signs at all exits as required by the Police Department
- Place "road closed" and/or "detour" signs as directed by the Public Works Department
- Provide "fenced" enclosure as required by ABC and the Police Department

A non-refundable application fee of \$50.00, payable to the City of Sonora, is to be submitted with this application.

Sonora Tap Room's 1st outdoor event on Linoberg Street was very successful! There were no issues or complaints that we are aware of, other than the fencing being a bit intimidating. Altogether it was a great day, and a nice addition to our downtown events.

We'd like to request permission from the City Council to use Linoberg Street on Saturday, June 23 from 5-11 pm for our 2nd outdoor event. The Sonora Tap Room is planning a "Summer Kick-off" event featuring a tap takeover with local brewery, Dustbowl Brewing, out of Turlock CA. We also have live music from Alex and the XO's.

At this time, we are requesting that the City allow us to serve beer & wine outside on Linoberg St, in the proposed area (see attached drawing). This area will be temporarily blocked off from public use and monitored by a security person with one way in and one way out. We will also use wrist bands to further regulate who is of legal drinking age. We have the necessary permit from ABC, which is good for 1 year.
