BUSINESS LICENSE FEE CALCULATION SHEET
COIN OPERATED VENDING MACHINES

Chapter 5.10.250 of the Sonora Municipal Code. **E. Coin Machines--Outside Owner.** Every person commencing, transacting and carrying on at other than a fixed place of business in the City the business of lending, renting, leasing, or otherwise distributing any coin-operated machine while retaining title thereto, shall pay an annual license tax of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each machine.

Annual license taxes shall be due the first day of JANUARY of each year, and delinquent after JANUARY 31st.

*On October 11, 2017 Governor Brown signed into law AB-1379 which amends the SB-1186 which adds a state fee of \$4.00 on any applicant for a local business license or similar instrument or permit, or renewal thereof. The purpose is to increase disability access and compliance with construction-related accessibility requirements and to develop educational resources for businesses in order to facilitate compliance with federal and state disability laws, as specified.

Under federal and state law, compliance with disability access laws is a serious and significant responsibility that applies to all California building owners and tenants with buildings open to the public.
