Cases For discussion:

19-1182. On September, 5, 2019, 33-year-old Roy Allan Chandler Jr., of Sonora, was arrested for outstanding felony and misdemeanor warrants, possession of methamphetamine and violation of felony probation. Over the past several days, Chandler had leg-bailed from Officers' on two separate occasions in an attempt to evade capture for his felony warrant. Early this morning, Officers' located Chandler near the 700 block of West Stockton Road. During the arrest and search of Chandler, Officers' located a bag of methamphetamine. Chandler was booked at the County Jail on his no-bail felony warrant for weapons charges as well as fresh charges related to drug possession and violating the terms of his probation.

19-1207. Just after 4:00 am, on September 11th, the Police Department received calls from a passerby and then an alarm company of a burglary in progress at the cannabis dispensary on Mono Way. When Officers' arrived on scene, they found that a door to the business had been pried open and the interior in disarray. Unfortunately, the suspects had fled the scene prior to the Officers' arrival. After a thorough review of the inventory, the owner of the business reports a loss of over \$69,000 in cannabis and cannabis products. Video surveillance from the business indicates the four male suspects had used a black sedan to carry out this crime. The vehicle they used is believed to be a 2015 or 2016 Honda CR-V with paper dealer plates. The investigation is on-going and some leads on the suspects have come in to the police department.

Recruitments:

- 1 vacant Police Lieutenant position; recruitment pending.
- 1 vacant part-time Dispatcher position; recruitment pending.
- The second of 2 part-time SRO positions funded by a grant from DOJ is in the final stages of the hiring process.

Field Training Program:

- Reserve Officer Duffy continues with his field training.

- SRO Schrantz has started phase 1 of field training with Officer Mallon.

Training:

- Police Officer Recruit Michael Paulsen started the academy on September 28th and is expected to graduate on March 25th, 2020.
- Dispatcher/IT Cyndi Nordvik attended a 16-hour Active Threat course on September 1th and 19th.
- Officer Lance Durham attended a 40-hour Perishable Skills Update course from September 16th to September 19th.
- Sergeant Hankins, Officer Brandow and Officer Carrasco attended an 8-hour Asset Forfeiture course on September 12th.

Community/Special Events:

- On September 11th, the SPD Explorer Post placed flags along Washington St. in observance of Patriot's Day.

Range:

- Range qualifications took place on September 30. The next range qualification will be in December.
