# MEMORANDUM

**SUBJECT:** Agenda Items 4, 5, 6 New Business

The following items have been listed on the agenda for Council consideration to add to a future agenda if they merit consideration.

A funding allocation for the Linoberg Street closure to resurface the street utilizing SB 1 and/or gas tax funds – the Committee would like to resurface the street with a material that is more pedestrian friendly. This work could consist of a leveling course and surface treatment similar to a tennis court finish. Cost estimates range up to \$8,000.

A ballot measure for a TOT and/or sales tax increase to provide additional general fund revenues – the County is considering both a TOT tax increase from the current 10 percent to 12 or 14 percent and various sales tax options. The City may want to consider similar measures.

A ballot measure to change the City Clerk position from elected to appointed – the current City Clerk position is vacant and Councilmember Such is serving as City Clerk Pro-Tem. The Council has previously discussed the possibility of making this an appointed position.

The filing deadline for a ballot measure for the primary election is December 6.
