Bid protests may be submitted only by a party that has submitted a bid or proposal in response to the contract solicitation. All such protests shall be in writing and shall contain a complete statement of the legal grounds for the protest and all facts relevant to the protest. All protests shall be accompanied by all documentation supporting the grounds for the appeal, and shall include the name, address, and telephone number of the protesting party and the person representing the protesting party, if any. The validity of the submitted protest will be considered and heard by City staff. The City will not consider award of the contract until a final determination is issued with respect to any protest received.
