Project: Washington-Stockton Corridor – Downtown Transit & Accessibility Improvement Project

Plan Holders:

The following additions, deletions or modifications shall become a part of the Contract/Bid Documents:

Item No. 1:

Working Days for this project have been increased to 130.

Item No. 2:

A new Bid Sheet is attached to this Addendum and posted separately to the project information on the City's website www.sonoraca.com. Time Related Overhead has been revised to show 130 Working Days. The Bid Sheet has also been enlarged to make completion easier.

Item No. 3:

There are two major events that will occur in Downtown Sonora during the construction period. "Magic of the Night", Friday, August 5th and "Sonora Christmas Parade", Thursday, November 25th. The ADA compliant curb ramps and crosswalks shall be provided at all four corners of Washington/Stockton intersection and on the south side of the Green/Stockton intersection for the Christmas Parade. Full vehicular access to Washington Street, Stockton Street, and Green Street shall be provided for the Christmas Parade. Pedestrians must be able to safely navigate through the construction area for both events.

Item No. 4:

The project's Geotechnical Report prepared by WRECO is attached to this Addendum and posted separately to the project information on the City's website www.sonoraca.com for reference.

Item No. 5:

The Engineer's estimate for this project is in the range of \$1.6 million to \$1.8 million.

Item No. 6:

Hardscape as identified in the project plans shall be 0.33' PCC, integrally colored "Tan", over 0.33' AB (Class II) compacted to 95%. Contractor to provide color submittal for City approval prior to construction.

Item No. 7:

Two locations not previously identified on the project plans shall install sidewalk to match existing sidewalk color and joint pattern. See attached Plan L-01 for reference. Contractor shall provide submittals and samples for City approval of color and joint pattern at each location shown. Attached Bid Schedule includes new bid item 60A Minor Concrete (Sidewalk)(Match Existing), and revised quantity for Bid Item 60.

Item No. 8:

Bus Shelter: Per Note 1 on Sheet UD-03 Urban Design Plans, "Information contained in this sheet is for aesthetic and functional design intent only. No instructions for structural appropriateness have been made. It is the responsibility of the contractor to provide engineered, stamped show drawings by a structural engineer registered in the State of California."

Item No. 9:

Bus Shelter: Design of shelter is to be consistent with the intent and aesthetics shown on the project plans. CAD Files are not available for the Laser Cut Steel Panels.

Item No. 10:

Contractor is responsible for all Quality Control, including all materials testing as necessary, in accordance with the applicable sections of the State Standard Specifications, and is considered included in the price paid for various bid items. City CM will perform Quality Assurance.

Item No. 11:

The project did not assume night work beyond setting of traffic control features. As per Paragraph 4, Page 3 of the City's Caltrans Encroachment Permit (available as shown in the Notice to Bidders), all night-time work requires COZEEP and all COZEEP related costs will be the responsibility of the contractor.
